Foreword

Balulalow for four trebles and string quartet was composed in late 2008. The present version is scored for SSAA and can be performed by a female choir or four soloists. The accompaniment remains true to the original, but is easily adaptable for string orchestra (an optional double bass part has been added). The piece takes the cradle-song style suggested by the poem as its inspiration; indeed the word Balulalow is old Scottish for lullaby. The rocking string quartet accompaniment that dominates the piece and the long lyrical lines help express the lullaby mood, whilst the augmented fourth motif, which can be found on the words “young Jesus sweet” and throughout, adds an air of uncertainty. The words, written around 1567 by James, John, and Robert Wedderburn, are first sung by solo treble before being taken up by the vocal quartet, leading towards a climax on the final line of each stanza.

Vorwort des Komponisten

Balulalow für 4 Frauenstimmen und Streichquartett entstand Ende 2008. Die vorliegende Fassung ist für SSAA und kann von Frauenchor oder Solisten aufgeführt werden. Die Begleitung ist in enger Anlehnung an die ursprüngliche Streichquartett-Fassung für Streichorchester eingerichtet (ein optionaler Bass-Part wurde hinzugefügt). Das Stück übernimmt den Wiegenlied-Stil der durch das Gedicht vorgegeben ist als Inspiration; so ist auch das Wort Balulalow das alt Schottische für Wiegenlied. Die schwingende Streichquartettbegleitung hilft zusammen mit den langen lyrischen Linien die Wiegenliedstimmung auszudrücken, während das Motiv der übermäßigen Quarte über den Worten „young Jesus sweet“ einen beständigen Klang von Unsicherheit hinzufügt. Der Text, um 1567 von James, John, and Robert Wedderburn geschrieben, wird zunächst von einer Solostimme gesungen bevor er vom Frauenchor (Quartett) zu einem Höhepunkt in der letzten Zeile jeder Strophe geführt wird.
